



GAULT NATURE RESERVE TO BEGIN PROGRESSIVELY REOPENING ON JUNE 8, 2020

Starting on June 8, McGill University will begin progressively reopening the Gault Nature Reserve. Only annual pass holders will have access to the trails during this phase. Activities and guest services (including washrooms) will remain suspended until further notice.

As per regulations from federal and provincial public health authorities, the University is carefully and gradually introducing tightened measures to ensure the safety of its professors, staff and students as it reopens its campus. We also want to keep our visitors safe and prevent the spread of COVID-19 as we progressively reopen the Gault Nature Reserve and our research station. The University is closely monitoring the situation as it evolves.

During the gradual opening phase, the Gault Nature Reserve will adapt its services as public health guidelines evolve. In these unprecedented times, we appreciate your patience and understanding as we navigate this process in a responsible and safe manner.
